Naproxen as an adjuvant therapy for the treatment of obsessive-compulsive disorder (OCD): A randomized double blind and placebo controlled clinical trial

Protocol summary

Study aim

Investigating the effect of Naproxen for the treatment of patients with obsessive-compulsive disorder (OCD)

Design

Randomized double blind and placebo-controlled clinical trial

Settings and conduct

This study will be performed on patients with obsessive-compulsive disorder attending Roozbeh Hospital

Participants/Inclusion and exclusion criteria

Inclusion criteria: age between 18 to 60 years old; diagnosis of OCD based on DSM-5; score of >21 in Yale-Brown obsessive-compulsive scale (Y-BOCS).
Exclusion criteria: receiving any treatment up to 6 weeks before the start of the trial; presence of another psychiatric disorder.

Intervention groups

Intervention group: patients are initially treated with fluoxetine 20 mg daily; reaching 80 mg per day by the end of the tenth week, plus naproxen 250 mg twice daily. Control group: patients are initially treated with fluoxetine 20 mg daily, reaching 80 mg daily by the end of the tenth week, plus placebo, twice daily.

Randomization (investigator's opinion)

Randomization description
Permuted block randomization: using A and B blocks with n=4; AABB, ABAB, ABBA, BABA, BAAB, BBAA. We randomly use the blocks to achieve total sample size. ("A" and "B" are the study groups).

Blinding (investigator's opinion)
Double blinded

Blinding description
The participants, care providers and outcome assessors will be blind regarding grouping. All the participants believe that they are taking the main medication (the participants who are taking placebo are not aware of it). Care providers and outcome assessors do not know which participants have received the main medication and which participants have received placebo. Thus, there is no orientation in their work process.
