Comparing the effectiveness of social stories and cognitive rehabilitation on social skills, executive functions, verbal and non-verbal communication skills and stereotypical behaviors of children with high-functioning autism

Protocol summary

Study aim

Determining the effectiveness of social stories and cognitive rehabilitation on social skills, executive functions, verbal and non-verbal communication skills, and stereotypical behaviors in children with high-functioning autism.

Design

A clinical trial with a control group and two intervention groups, single-blind, randomized, phase 3 will be conducted with 15 participants in each group, using SPSS software for analysis.

Settings and conduct

After selecting the samples and placing them in two intervention groups and a control group, the intervention will be implemented in the researcher's office in Isfahan, in the form of 14 individual sessions for each member of the intervention group, and a one-way blinding method will be used.

Participants/Inclusion and exclusion criteria

Inclusion criteria: Age between 6 to 11 years; Higher than average intelligence quotient; Diagnosis of high-functioning autism based on assessment by a therapist from counseling centers; Absence of sensory impairments. Exclusion criteria: Receiving simultaneous rehabilitation; Undergoing medical or psychiatric treatments that interfere with the intervention process.

Intervention groups

Intervention One: 12 recorded social stories will be listened to and acted out, and questions will be asked to understand the situation. Intervention Two: An emotion-based rehabilitation package for emotional abilities and mental states will be administered. Intervention Three: Control group samples, who will not receive any intervention.

Main outcome variables

Improving the quality of life for children with autism and

their families; Developing effective educational programs for children with autism in schools and rehabilitation centers; Preventing long-term social and behavioral problems in children with autism; Facilitating the social participation of children with autism in public and educational environments.

Inclusion criteria:

Age between 6 to 11 years. Having an intelligence quotient higher than average. High-functioning autism diagnosis based on the assessment of therapists at counseling centers. Lack of sensory deficits such as deafness and blindness. Informed consent and willingness to cooperate of children and their families.

Exclusion criteria:

Receiving simultaneous rehabilitation Absence for more than two sessions. Undergoing medical and psychiatric treatments that intervene in the educational process.

Randomization description

The statistical population is children with high-functioning autism in Isfahan, who will be selected through purposive sampling (based on research criteria) and then placed in the first and second experimental groups and the control group by simple random assignment, so that everyone has an equal chance of being selected.

Blinding (investigator's opinion)

Description

Intervention group 1: Effectiveness of social stories: 12 social stories (one social story per session) will be recorded and played by the researcher, re-read, related pictures will be shown, and then acted out and questions will be asked to understand the situation. The stories will be explained to parents so that the necessary points can be observed in similar situations. This intervention will be carried out in 14 sessions, 60 minutes each, 2 sessions per week.

Intervention group 2: Effectiveness of cognitive rehabilitation: Emotion-based cognitive rehabilitation package, which teaches basic emotions to the individual at 10 different levels and provides feedback based on

the individual's response. At the end of the session, the situations will be explained to the subject's parents. In each session, the subject will be asked questions about the content taught. This intervention will be carried out on the intervention group over 14 sessions of 60 minutes (three sessions per week).
